- metaphor of war, like planes on "missions of death"
- universal killer, eradicating, deadly poisons
- farmer's decision to destroy the birds despite lack not being necessary
- judge and jury (continued through rest of the piece)

SECTION 2: HUMANS

- boys roaming the woods and fields
- her use of hypophora and rhetorical questions
- return to war metaphor, "lethal film"

SECTION 3: CALL TO ACTION

- ____metaphor comparing the use of poisons to the ripples on a pond
- image of the scale of lifeless birds juxtaposed with leaves eaten by beetles
- ____the power of the authoritarian making the decision, contrasted with the millions who do/should care
